HARRY R. BAIN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP - 2022

GENERAL RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS

Two college scholarships will be awarded to sons, grandsons, daughters, granddaughters or legal dependents of members of IBEW Local 340.

1st place - \$1,000.00

2nd place “Runner Up” - \$500.00

These scholarships must be used for study at any accredited college, university, or trade school in the United States. The local 340 scholarships will not impose restrictions of any kind on the course of study. Recipients may accept any other grants or awards, which do not rule out scholarship aid from other sources.

WHO MAY APPLY:

Sons, grandsons, daughters, granddaughters and legal dependents of local 340 members may apply for the scholarships. The parent, grandparent or legal guardian of the applicant must have been a member of Local 340 for at least (1) year preceding the date of the application.

Sons, grandsons, daughters, granddaughters and legal dependents of deceased members of Local 340 may also apply for scholarships. The parent, grandparent or legal guardian of the applicant must have been a member of Local 340 for at least (1) year immediately preceding the date of death.

The applicants **must be senior high school students who have, or will be, graduated at the end of the spring semester (beginning in 2023)** enrolled in public, private or parochial schools. Applicants must plan to attend a college, university or trade school anywhere in the United States during the academic year and who are able to meet the academic requirements for entrance into the college, university, or trade school of their choice. Students selected for the scholarship must have achieved not less than a “B” average in their high school work. **Applications will be accepted on or before March 11, 2022.**

Upon receipt of the applications and required forms, Local 340 will verify the membership of the parent, grandparent or legal guardian. The application will then be submitted for judging to a University Scholarship Selection Committee, an independent outside group composed entirely of professional educators.

Apart from verifying the eligibility of the applicant, Local 340 will not exercise any choice among the various applicants, or indicate in any way, that one of the applicants should be favored over another. Based on factors normally used in awarding academic scholarships, the University Scholarship Selection Committee will submit to Local 340 Executive Board recommendations for the top five (5) finalists. The list of potential winners and their qualifications will be reviewed and studied by the Executive Board and the scholarship winners selected.

Scholarship winners will be announced at the July 2022 union meeting of IBEW Local 340 (pending current meeting guidelines). The checks will be made payable to the college, university or trade school they plan to attend and a letter will be sent to recipient winner.

INSTRUCTIONS:

All of the following items must be received by MARCH 11, 2022:

1. **THE APPLICATION** - to be filled out and returned by the applicant.
2. **A REPORT ON THE APPLICANT AND A HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT-** Report (or letter) should be done by the School principal or the person the Principal designates on the applicant. This report (or letter) should be mailed directly to Local 340 with the High School Transcript – marked “Confidential – Transcript Enclosed”.
3. **LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION** - applicants should submit one to three letters of recommendation giving information about their character and ability. These may be from teachers, community leaders, family friends or others who know the applicant. Please submit all letters of recommendation with the application.
4. **PHOTOGRAPH** - a recent photograph, preferably two inches by three inches, with the applicant’s name written on the back. (Photo should be clear enough to reproduce in the IBEW journal.)
